(page 257)



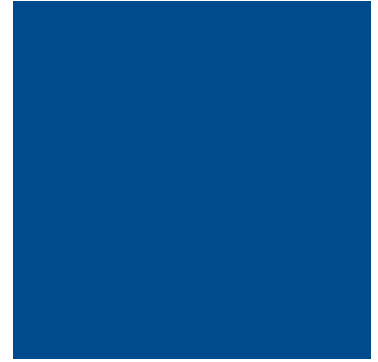
*noun*

a raw material or primary agricultural product that can be bought and sold, such as copper or coffee.

a useful or valuable thing, such as water or time.

a difference or contrast between similar things or people

*verb*

officially join or become attached to an  
organization

the unjust or prejudicial treatment of different categories of people or things, esp. on the grounds of race, age, or sex

# dominant

*adjective*

most important, powerful, or influential

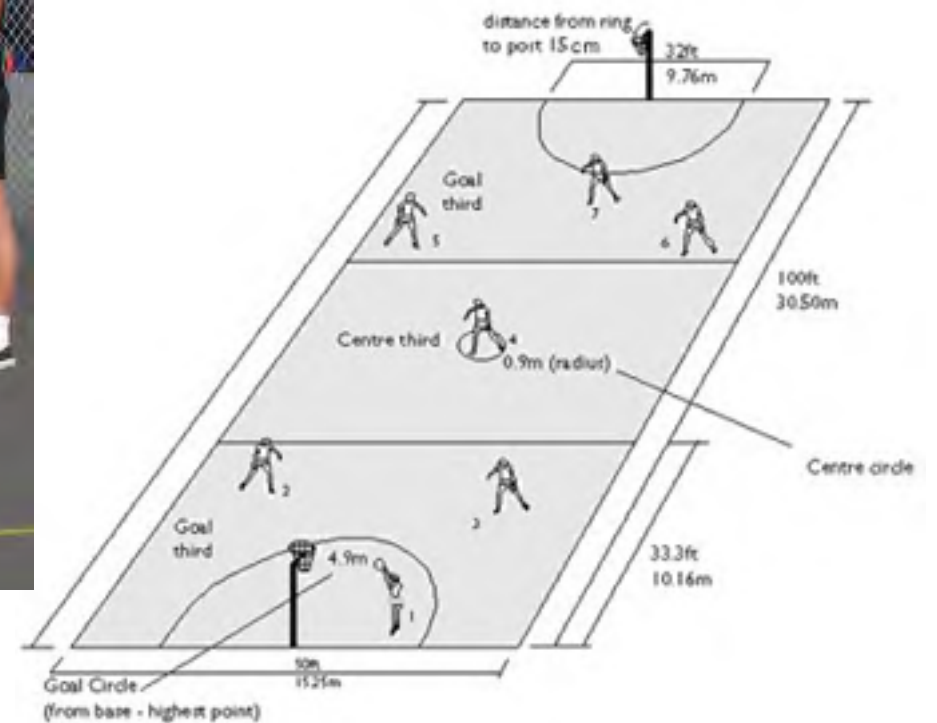
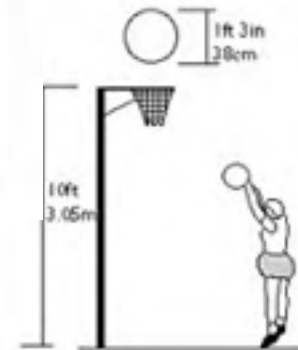
